Introduction:

Training at the La Plata Center began in 1990 and the center was inaugurated as a WGO Training Center on March 21, 2007. Since its founding, the La Plata Training Center has received more than 400 scholars, most from the Latin American region.



Aims / Goals:

Training in endoscopy and endoscopic surgery.

Facilities:

The La Plata Training Center is located in the Gral. San Martín Hospital, a referral hospital situated in the Province of Buenos Aires (population 15 million). The hospital has 500 beds and all clinical and surgical specialties. The Gastroenterology Services (30 doctors) include the Department of Endoscopy, Department of Hepatology, Department of Motility, and an Endoscopic Emergency Ward (24 hours). Five hundred endoscopic procedures are performed monthly, 60% of which are therapeutic.



The Unit of Nutritional Support and Malabsorbtive Diseases has been recently integrated into the center and began its academic activities in 2009 with an E-Learning course on Nutrition.

Teaching Facilities:

- Maximum number of trainees that can participate per training period: one
- Number of courses which could held per year, given that proper funding were available: six
- Months in which courses could be organized: January-June. July-December
- Number of trainees / faculty for which accommodations are available: The center has no accommodation. It is provided by the endoscopy company.

Faculty and Staff:

- 6 Staff Doctors
- 7 Endoscopic Emergency Doctors (24 hours)
- 12 Fellows
- 15 Nurses

Equipment and Procedures

Please see the attached entitled "La Plata Equipment" for an overview of the center's current equipment as well as the number of procedures performed yearly.

Areas of Training:

- Diagnostic upper endoscopy, colonoscopy, enteroscopy, ERCP and pancretoscopy.
- Upper endoscopic surgery, sclerotherapy, banding ligation, dilation, stent placement, argon-beam, polypectomy, EMR, clips, diagnostic and interventional EUS
- Colonic endoscopic surgery, EMR, dyeing colorant, dilation and stent placement
- Endoscopic surgery of the bile ducts and pancreas: EPT, placement of stent, mechanical lithotripsy, cholangiography, mother and baby
- Therapeutic endoscopy



Training/Courses Offered:

Six scholarships are offered per year for training in basic therapeutic endoscopy and ERCP.

Duration: 6 months to 1 year

2 Day Hands-on Course in Therapeutic Endoscopy (porcine models) - Held twice annually

Dates: April 7 – 8, 2011

Dates: November 24 – 25, 2011

Live Demonstration Course: November 10-11, 2011
