In collaboration with the Hellenic Society of Gastroenterology, the WGO is proud to inform our member societies that the second advanced **Trial Design Workshop will be held in Athens, Greece** in November 2010.

Based on the principles of our successful Train the Trainers program, this workshop will run over two days, and include both small group work and interactive learning sessions.

Topics include:

- Types of clinical trials

- Data analysis
- Statistics for clinicians
- Publication
- Ethical considerations

We ask all participants to ensure that they are leaders in their field, as well as fluent in English.

Successful participants are required to cover their own hotel accommodation for their stay in Athens, as well as travel including ground transportation from the airport to their hotel. The Workshop will be held in the Alexandros Hotel, located in central Athens, and we would also recommend that participants reserve their accommodations there. The daily room rate for a single or twin room is €135.00, including breakfast.

If participants decide not to stay at the hotel where the actual workshop will take place, then they are also required to cover their travel to and from the course site. The local host society will provide catering for two days as well as all educational materials.


